General information on data processing

Legal basis for the processing of personal data

In accordance with Art. 13 GDPR, we hereby inform you of the legal basis for our data processing. Unless the legal basis is specified in the privacy policy, the following applies:

The legal basis for obtaining consent is Art. 6 (1) lit. a in conjunction with Art. 7 GDPR. The legal basis for processing for the fulfillment of our services and the implementation of contractual measures as well as for responding to inquiries is Art. 6 (1) lit. b GDPR. The legal basis for processing for the fulfillment of our legal obligations is Art. 6 para. 1 lit. c GDPR. If the processing of your data is necessary to safeguard a legitimate interest of our company or a third party and the interests, fundamental rights, and freedoms of the data subject do not override the aforementioned interest, Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f GDPR serves as the legal basis for processing. In the event that vital interests of the data subject or another natural person require the processing of personal data, Art. 6 para. 1 lit. d GDPR serves as the legal basis.

Data deletion and storage period

We adhere to the principles of data minimization pursuant to Art. 5 para. 1 lit. c GDPR and storage limitation pursuant to Art. 5 para. 1 lit. e GDPR. We only store your personal data for as long as this is necessary to achieve the purposes stated here or as required by the statutory retention periods. Once the respective purpose has ceased to exist or once these retention periods have expired, the corresponding data will be deleted as soon as possible.

Rights of the data subject

As a data subject within the meaning of the GDPR, you have the possibility to assert various rights. Right of withdrawal:

Right to object:

If we cannot demonstrate a legitimate interest in the processing that outweighs your interests, rights, and freedoms, or if the processing serves to assert, exercise, or defend legal claims, we will refrain from processing your data after you have objected.

If the processing of personal data is used for direct marketing purposes, you also have the right to object at any time. The same applies to profiling related to direct marketing. Here too, we will no longer process personal data once you have objected.

Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority:

If you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the GDPR, you have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, in particular in the member state of your habitual residence, place of work, or place of the alleged violation, without prejudice to any other administrative or judicial remedy.

Right to data portability:

If your data is processed automatically on the basis of your consent or the fulfillment of a contract, you have the right to receive this data in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format. Right to information, correction, and deletion:

When you visit our website, we automatically collect and store information in so-called server log files. This information is automatically transmitted by your browser to our server or to the server of our hosting company.

This includes:
